

## About Dr. Kingry



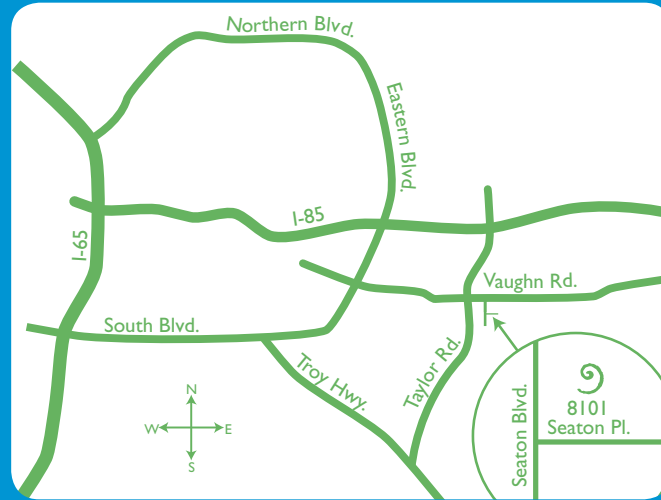

## Early Treatment

The American Association of Orthodontists recommends that children should first visit an orthodontist at age 7. Warning signs of orthodontic problems can be detected from a child's bite even before all teeth erupt, and may include:

- The upper teeth protruding.
- The upper teeth covering too much of the lower teeth.
- The upper teeth fitting behind the lower teeth.
- The teeth are crowding or overlapping.
- There are noticeably large gaps between teeth.
- The line between the two upper front teeth and the two lower front teeth not lining up properly.

Beginning treatment at an early age allows many orthodontics problems to be corrected without the need for more costly and extensive treatment. Also as the child experiences rapid skeletal growth, Dr. Kingry can use this natural growth to assist in providing a beautiful smile to last a lifetime.
